BAND STORY


"Dave's music career began in Fredericton, New Brunswick in the late 70's with the Foxtooth Bluegrass Band ("Folk Music in Overdrive"), and then Stringfever (more of a folk/rock band) in the 80's. Dave ended up in Ontario and played for a number of years with the Max Woolaver Band in Toronto (Max is from Digby, Nova Scotia and the band is a six piece band playing all original folk/roots music), and still plays with the Stephanie Bird Band (a four piece band playing pop/folk/rock) based in Brighton. Dave was also a founder and organizer of the Lighthouse Café, a popular concert series in Brighton that featured folk musicians from across Canada. In 2004 Dave teamed up with his old buddy from Foxtooth, John Hughes, who now lives in Mahone Bay, Nova Scotia. As Hughes & Curtis, Dave and John released "Turn of the Tide" in 2006, a 15 song cd produced by Kevin Barry Evans and recorded mostly at Sonic Temple in Halifax. Although Dave and John have trimmed their playing schedule a bit, Dave is continuing with his solo career and is currently recording a new cd of original material."
