"Tinker's Damn has been playing Irish traditional, Celtic, and Maritime music since 1996 in pubs, clubs and bars throughout Nova Scotia and New Brunswick. From 5000+ crowds at Canada Day celebrations to weddings and corporate functions, the Tinkers deliver lively pub favorites, sea-shantys, and ballads written a century ago, as well as originals that blend in seamlessly. Their CDs released in 1998 (Half Way Home) and 2000 (Chebucto Town) have received favorable reviews, but their live shows are their stock in trade. Their determination to stay the course with traditional music in content as well as spirit saw the Tinkers chosen to provide entertainment for an Irish pub night during Irish Dancing competitions held at SMU, and has made them a sought-after feature band for more St. Patrick's Day celebrations than they can count (or remember, quite frankly). A night with "the lads" is sure to leave the crowd hoarse and happy. The current lineup features Larry Rankin on guitar, mandolin, tin whistle and lead vocal; Brian Smeltzer on bass, vocals, and bodhran; and Terry Saunders on guitar, mandolin and vocals."
